

# Operating rules

These Operating Rules form an integral part of the General Terms and Conditions and contain the fundamental regulations that are binding for all individuals present in the playrooms operated by MŠ Consulting, s.r.o., with its registered office at Záhradnícka 16, 900 28 Ivanka pri Dunaji, Company ID: 47529059, registered in the Commercial Register of the City Court Bratislava III, Section: Sro, Insert No. 94499/B.

### 1. Before entering the playrooms, participants are required to:

- sign the Declaration of Health Eligibility and Liability for Health Injury
- familiarize themselves with the General Terms and Conditions and the Operating Rules and sign them.

# 2. Entry to the playrooms is prohibited for:

- persons under the age of 18
- persons who have not signed the Declaration of Health Eligibility and Liability for Health Injury and the Declaration for Entry into the Playrooms.
- persons under the influence of alcohol, narcotic or psychotropic substances, or medications; participants must also refrain from consuming such substances during their stay in the playrooms.
- persons displaying physical or health-related unfitness (e.g., signs of infectious diseases, etc.).
- persons accompanied by animals.
- persons outside of operating hours.
- 3. Participants must not enter areas designated exclusively for playroom staff

## 4. Participants are required to store all their belongings,

that could cause injury to themselves or others in the designated storage area - the locker room. Valuables or other valuable items must not be left in the locker room; participants can store them at the playrooms' reception (against written confirmation).

# 5. In the playrooms:

- participants must not consume alcohol, narcotic or psychotropic substances, or medications during their entire stay in the playrooms.
- participants must not drink, eat, or smoke outside of designated areas.
- participants must use the equipment and tools in the playrooms only in accordance with their intended purpose and the guidelines provided by the manufacturer or playrooms staff; otherwise, they are liable for any damage and must compensate for it.
- taking photographs, videos, or any other visual or audio recordings, as well as their usage, is solely the responsibility of the participants.
- no participant may force another participant into any activities against their will, nor may they be forced into any activities themselves.
- oparticipants must immediately report any health hazards or injuries to the playrooms staff.
- participants must promptly report any damage to the equipment and/or tools in the playrooms upon discovery; otherwise, they are liable for the damage and must compensate for it.
- participants must not engage in any activities that violate applicable legal regulations

# 6. If multiple participants are responsible for damage,

they are jointly and severally liable for compensating for it. If it is impossible to determine which participant is responsible for the damage, all participants in the playrooms will be held jointly and severally liable.
